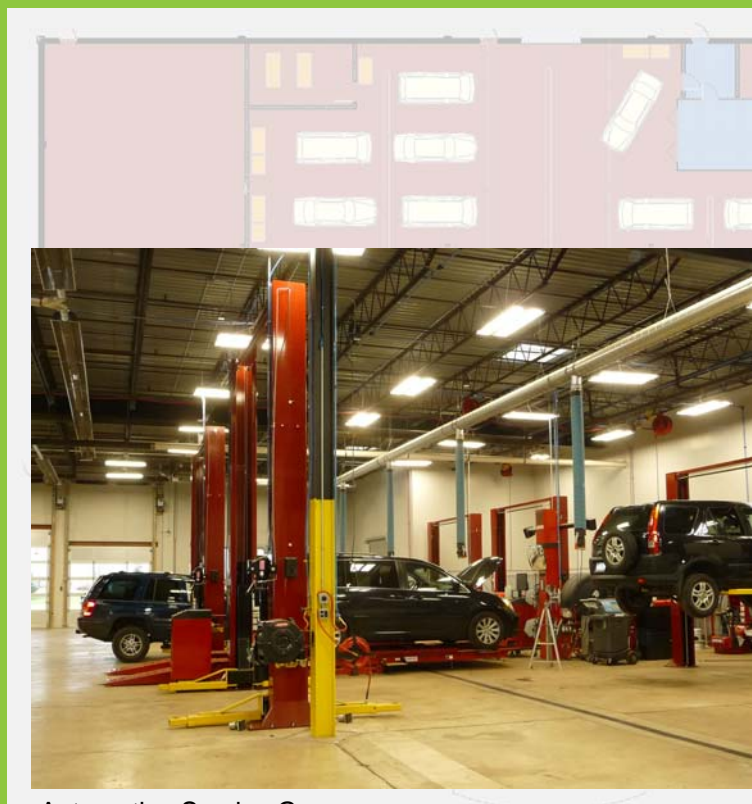




Gates Automotive Center Henrietta NY

Advantage Federal Credit Union Gates NY

The Credit Union desired to have a facility that included both branch and their corporate offices. They acquired an existing bank building that was a local icon in the greater Rochester area (Columbia Bank, ca. 1973). The existing building was renovated using a neutral palette to update the look while being respectful of the existing glulam beams and brick. New functions incorporated into the existing building included customer service offices, waiting area, and ATM. A 1,500 square foot, 2 story addition houses their new corporate offices.



Building Reuse

According to Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) building reuse is defined as "extending the life cycle of existing building stock, conserve resources, retain cultural resources, reduce waste, and reduce environmental impacts of new building as they relate to materials manufacturing and transport."
